Scrum sees to it that people work together in a collaborative, productive and enjoyable way. eduScrum is Scrum tailored to the needs and objectives of education. Designed by Willy, it brings principles and energy of Scrum into the classroom.

The most exciting thing about eduScrum is that students take ownership of their own learning. Working with the content of any curriculum, they manage their own projects, their time involved and their learning process. eduScrum helps students to grow as a team as well as individuals, while at the same time create an enjoyable and stimulating atmosphere in the classroom. The teacher plays a vital and dynamic role in facilitating everything that happens.

At the end of the training participants will understand the eduScrum framework and have the tools to start their eduScrum lessons.
